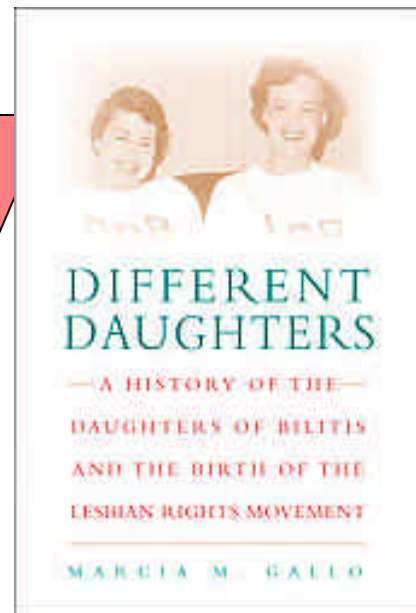

Nearly fifteen years before the Stonewall Rebellion and the birth of gay liberation in New York came the Daughters of Bilitis (DOB). Launched in 1955 in response to the oppressive anti-homosexual climate of the McCarthy era, DOB challenged the silence and contempt that surrounded women-loving-women for so many generations.

Marcia will read from her new book, followed by a discussion with Marcia, Katherine Acey, Executive Director of Astraea Lesbian Foundation for Justice, and Terry Boggis, Co-Chair of Queers for Economic Justice Board of Directors.
